

OCEANS OF PLASTIC

Every plastic item ever made on our planet is still on our planet. It does not degrade, but rather breaks down into smaller pieces. 80% of marine litter is plastic and there are over 5 trillion pieces of plastic floating worldwide.

Between 8 million and 12 million tonnes of plastic, enters our seas each and every year, and 46% of that is made up of fishing nets.

It is estimated that 1 million seabirds and over 100,000 marine mammals die each year due to plastic, either by ingesting it or becoming entangled in it.

A survey of fish caught off the British coast found that one in three were contaminated by plastic. We are in turn, ingesting plastic particles as it is bio-accumulated up the food chain. Plastic particles are carried by ocean currents where they congregate into five major plastic concentrations, or gyres, in the world's oceans. A plastic bottle can last 450 years in a marine environment! The longevity of plastic makes this not just a problem for today, but one that is going to last for hundreds of years. Attitudes however, are changing.

Nations such as New Zealand and Samoa are starting to ban the use of plastic bags. Scotland has banned single-use plastic straws from 2019. Taiwan has banned the use of popular plastic items and the United Kingdom has prohibited the manufacture of micro-beads. The applications for recycled plastics are also expanding. Plastics can be substituted for 20% of the sand used in cement manufacture. They can also be turned into building blocks and used in road building.


As sailors it is incumbent on us to do our utmost, to prevent plastic entering the ocean and to reduce our use. What can you do? Don't buy bottled water, swap disposable coffee cups for refillable ones, pick up ten pieces of plastic each time you are on the beach and never throw anything overboard when at sea. If we all make an effort, and lobby government to prohibit or reduce single-use plastic, we may be able to make a difference, and ensure the oceans and sea life are preserved for our grandchildren and great grandchildren to enjoy, just as we have done.

INTERNET AND WI-FI SERVICES AT SEA

WHY IS COMMUNICATION AT SEA DIFFERENT?

Silversea is providing internet service to all guests on board. As there are no "cell" towers or cable networks at sea, or in many of the remote places we visit, we use cutting-edge satellite technology that is very different to the high-speed broadband you may be accustomed to on land. At sea, any data is transmitted from the ship to a satellite in space. The satellite sends the data to a ground station where it connects to an internet service provider (ISP) and is then sent to the ship. The distance such data must travel is called "latency" and this is why onboard internet access can be inconsistent or, in some cases, unavailable. Satellite communications are also affected by weather and the ship's location. Should you wish to enhance your Internet Experience onboard, consider upgrading to Premium Access for the best calling, video calling and streaming available at sea.
