DID YOU KNOW?

Water properties are many. Physicists tell us that at normal temperatures, water should be a gas, but weak hydrogen holds its molecules together and make it liquid. As such, its is more viscous than might be expected with a high surface tension, which makes it 'wet'.

Much heat is required to convert water from solid to liquid form and from liquid to gas, and water has remarkable powers of dissolving other substances. When a solution is cooled and ice starts to form, the ice crystals separate themselves from the dissolved materials. Thus, the pack ice that forms on the sea is pure frozen water, albeit often contaminated with brine. When cooled, water molecules pack down together. This causes the density of the water to increase, but only as far as 4°C (38.5°F). Between 4°C and freezing point, water density decreases slightly. One important consequence of that is on a pond in winter time, cold water sinks from the surface to the bottom but the coldest layer of all forms on top. At 0°C (32°F), the molecules arrange themselves in layers to form ice crystals but remain sufficiently far away from one another to ensure that ice is less dense than water.

Thus for the same reason ice will form on the surface of a pond as against at depth, pack ice will form on the surface of the sea, not on the seabed. There are many forms of ice, depending on water temperature and pressure. Normally, a hard, fairly elastic and solid ice flows under pressure, producing those splendid monuments to gravity called glaciers. Likewise, ice passes readily from solid to gas as proved by the fact that clothes on a line will continue to dry when frozen stiff. Similarly, glaciers and ice sheets loose substance by "ablation" (evaporation) even when it is too cold for them to melt.
