

# LEGENDS OF THE DEEP: MARITIME MYTHS

#### **Ghost Ships**

Spectral ships portending doom have been spotted across the seven seas, the most famous being The Flying Dutchman. Less spectral, but more curious, is the story of the Marlborough, a sailing ship that disappeared without trace on a voyage to London from Lyttleton in New Zealand in March 1890. Nearly 20 years later, a newspaper reported that the vessel had been sighted twice off Cape Horn in a distressed condition, with moss-covered sails and skeletons on deck.

#### Chessie

Reports of a strange creature in the shallow waters of Chesapeake Bay in Maryland, U.S.A., affectionately dubbed Chessie after its Scottish cousin, Nessie, stretch back

some 200 years. In 1982, Chesapeake local, Robert Frew, managed to videotape the creature some 30 metres away from his waterside home. Analysis of his tape at the Smithsonian Institute concluded that it was indeed a living creature, but of a type 'unknown'.

#### Bermuda Triangle

The first mention of the 'deadly triangle' between Bermuda, Miami and San Juan in Puerto Rico dates back to 1952, but the area's reputation for devouring ships and planes has built up over three centuries. One researcher concluded that the Bermuda Triangle may have claimed up to 75 planes and 2,000 boats in the last 20 years! Theories range from methane hydrates, to freak waves, to

UFO's.

#### The Kraken

Some 2.5 kilometres across, and described as being the size of a 'floating island' in the Natural History of Norway (1792), the Kraken is undoubtedly the mother of all sea monsters. A feature of mariners' tales since the 12th century, the mighty creature, sadly, seems to have shrunk over the years, and most now believe it to be no more than a giant squid! Mermaids

Mermaids were once a common nautical feature, which dates back to an early sighting recorded in the log of explorer Henry Hudson when, on June 15, 1608, two of his crew reported seeing a creature with

"breasts like a woman's" and a "tail, which was like the tail of a Porpoise..."

#### Coelacanth

Thought to have become extinct some 65 million years ago, the sudden reappearance of this bright blue, 1.5-metre living fossil – the Coelacanth. in 1938 near Cape Town, South Africa, is one of the greatest stories in the annals of zoology. Bloop Scientists are baffled by a mysterious noise picked up by undersea microphones deployed during the Cold War to detect Soviet submarines. Based on a scientific study, the Bloop noise recorded in 1997 bore the frequency hallmark of marine animals, but proved far more powerful than the calls made by any creature known to man.

# INTERNET AND WI-FI SERVICES AT SEA

#### WHY IS COMMUNICATION AT SEA DIFFERENT?

Silversea is providing internet service to all quests on board. As there are no "cell" towers or cable networks at sea, or in many of the remote places we visit, we use cutting-edge satellite technology that is very different to the high-speed broadband you may be accustomed to on land. At sea, any data is transmitted from the ship to a satellite in space. The satellite sends the data to a ground station where it connects to an internet service provider (ISP) and is then sent to the ship. The distance such data must travel is called "latency" and this is why onboard internet access can be inconsistent or, in some cases, unavailable. Satellite communications are also affected by weather and the ship's location.
