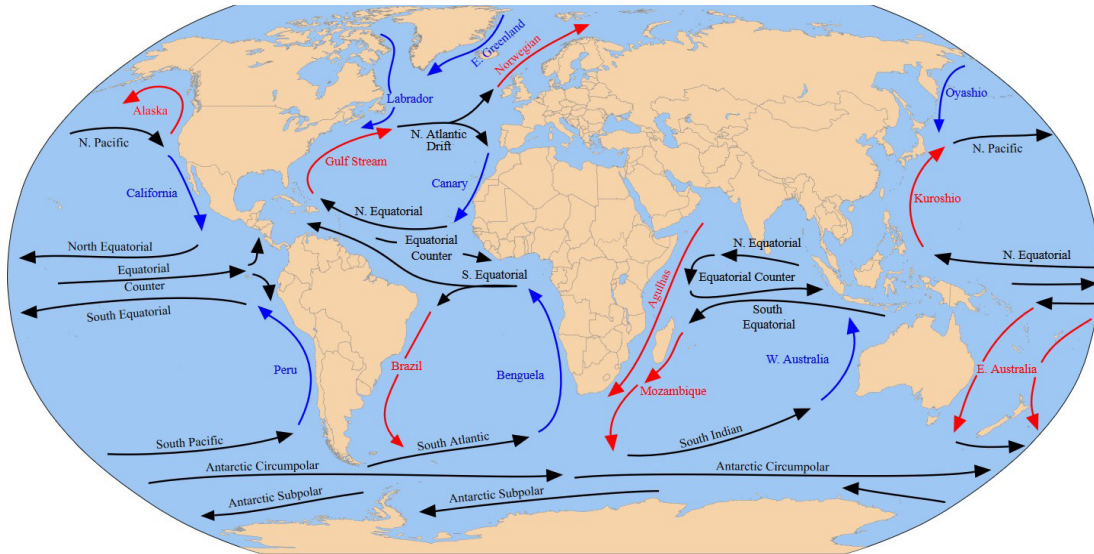

OUR WATER WORLD

The deepest point in the ocean is the Challenger Deep, in the lowest part of the Mariana Trench, east of the Philippines. It is 11 kilometers deep.

Here, pressure exceeds 11 tons per square meter, which is the equivalent of a person trying to hold 50 jumbo jets.

Surface temperatures of ocean waters can vary from -2°C (Polar Regions) to 36°C (Persian Gulf).

90% of all volcanic activity on Earth occurs in the ocean. It is estimated to contain some 10,000 volcanoes, of which at least 1,133 are active, and concentrated in a tiny patch of the South Pacific, not much bigger than the New York State.

The Great Barrier Reef is 2,000 kilometers long, and can be seen from the Moon.

The Earth's oceans contain a total of almost 20 billion tons of gold. Over 70% of the Earth's surface is covered by oceans: that is over 1,300 million cubic kilometers. If all of the oceans' salt content was dried, it would cover the world's land surface to a depth of 1.5 meters.

The Antarctic circumpolar current is the world's largest current. 21,000 kilometers in length, it transports around 136 million cubic meters per second through the Drake Passage between South America and Antarctica. That is over 150 times the flow of all the Earth's rivers put together, or the equivalent of 500 billion cans of soft drink per second. 99% of life on the planet is found in the ocean.

Twenty thousand leagues under the sea are some 100,000 kilometers, more than twice around the world. A league is nearly five kilometers.

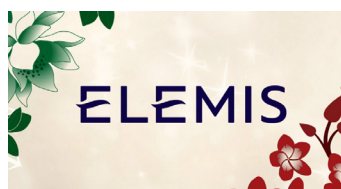

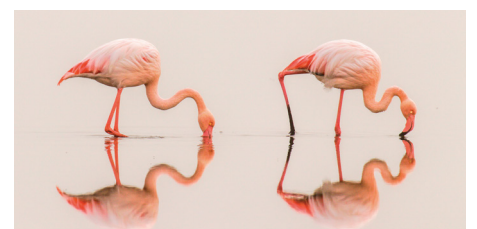
